Welcome to Oxford and the University of Mississippi! We are so pleased that you are joining us here for the 89th Annual Meeting of the Southeastern Section of the American Physical Society (SESAPS 2022). If you are giving an invited or contributed oral presentation, please email your slide files to sesaps22@phy.olemiss.edu no later than the night before your presentation. Your slides will be downloaded to a laptop in your session's room prior to the start of your session. Please arrive at your scheduled presentation session 15 minutes before the session starts to check in with the session chair and check your slides.

Map: You can find a University of Mississippi campus map at <https://map.olemiss.edu/>. The venue for the meeting is The Inn at Ole Miss, which is on the east side of campus, just to the northeast of The Grove in the center of campus. The Thursday evening poster session and Fish Fry/Shrimp Boil dinner will be held in The Pavilion, the basketball arena just south of the center of campus, adjacent to the football stadium. The SPS social, which follows the poster session and dinner, will take place in the Physics Department's Lewis Hall, just northeast across the street from The Pavilion. The Grad School Fair is located in Butler Auditorium in the Triplett Alumni Center, which is connected to The Inn. The Fair can be reached by following the signs along the 2nd floor hallway to Butler Auditorium, or by following the sidewalk up through the garden area behind The Inn.

Wifi: The eduroam network is available on campus. You may also join the OleMissGuest wireless network with the following username and password:

Breakfast: A light continental breakfast will be provided at The Inn each morning Thu-Sat starting one hour before the sessions begin.

Lunch: Conference guests will be provided free lunch Thu-Sat at the [Rebel Market](#), which offers several buffet style meal stations. You will simply need to present your meeting nametag to the cashiers, and they will swipe a SESAPS card to grant you entry. You may also purchase your own lunch from other dining venues on campus (e.g. Student Union food court, The Grill at 1810, etc.).

Oxford: The historic Square in Oxford is reachable by bus (<https://www.outransit.com/>) or a 15-minute walk from The Inn. There are a number of shops, famous restaurants and bars, and coffee shops on The Square. Other eating and shopping options are available via bus or short car ride. If you are interested in a low-impact hike, there is a short trail near the University Museum that leads through Bailey Woods to [Rowan Oak](#), the house of William Faulkner. The University Museum also houses a historically significant [collection of 19th century scientific instruments](#) that is worth a visit.
